Experienced in the use of **ENDOSCOPIC AND OTHER MINIMALLY INVASIVE TECHNIQUES**, Dr. Salibian says these approaches are ideal for younger patients with limited excess skin. "For a face- or browlift, a patient in her forties may only need to reposition the tissue done with an incision in the scalp, with minimal bruising, numbness and down time." Often in lieu of sutures, Dr. Salibian uses an absorbable fixation device to hold repositioned tissue in place. The doctor notes that while new high-tech treatments deserve their acclaim, he remains a fan of traditional hips and tucks when circumstances demand.
